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The school

Mission:

At Valeo, we offer personalized attention to children who don't thrive in traditional, crowded classrooms. Despite good intentions, regular classes often lack resources for the necessary attention and challenges. Valeo does guarantee personal attention, promotes skills and nurtures and develops talents. Here, every child feels heard and seen.

At Valeo, we encourage children to feel their worth, to grow and to truly be empowered. We believe that every child deserves to thrive in a stimulating educational environment. Our goal is full development, learning to deal with stimuli, and strengthening self-esteem in society.

We prepare children for the outside world through controlled, unpredictable situations and confrontations. We avoid creating a 'bubble'. Our groups share similar spaces, communication, and structure. The rooms are low-stimulus and exude tranquillity. Conversations with the teacher or Saskia, the director and life coach, offer children an outlet. We maintain a close connection between classmates and teachers, with regular conversations and reports with parents.

Our education is suitable for children who:

- Be sensitive to stimuli or highly sensitive;

- Need extra guidance;
- Be moderately gifted or highly gifted;
- Happiness with a personal approach;
- Want to be heard, seen and appreciated;
- Want to feel safe enough to voice their opinions;
 - -Still have a lot to learn socially;

-They like to work and discover at their own pace and level. -Would like to build a connection with like-minded people



Organisation of education

Procedure

Everything is aimed at keeping education, communication and space as stimulusfree as possible. The students work in a quiet environment with a lot of clarity and guidance, on language, arithmetic, English, history, nature and geography. Often a laptop or other materials are used.

There are also opportunities for music lessons, if students are interested. Every morning there are sports lessons where the students get moving through sports and games. In addition to the regular lessons, the interests and needs of the students are also examined, from which projects arise. During these projects, the students develop their social skills, such as working together, but they also look at where their talents and qualities come to fruition.

Between lessons or during lessons, exercise on your own initiative is always allowed. Exercises that improve stimulus processing and games for social skills are done regularly.





Team

Valeo Primary School is run by Saskia, a dedicated headmistress who is also a life coach and children's coach. The combination of the headmistress and experienced teacher provides expertise in dealing with special needs of children, while a kindergarten teacher takes care of the little ones. Valeo has also been recognized as a training company for interns, providing a dynamic and educational environment for future professionals. Together, we strive for a holistic approach to education, in which every child thrives and grows.

After-school care

At Valeo, we offer after-school care for children from 4 to 12 years old. On Thursdays and Fridays there is pre-school care from 8:00 to 9:00 am, and on Tuesdays there is after-school care until 5:00 pm. We understand that flexibility is important, which is why childcare can be expanded upon request to meet the needs of both parents and children.





Care students

Valeo primary school distinguishes itself in the care of its students by having frequent individual conversations and calling in external resources, such as social workers, if necessary. In addition, the school creates low-stimulus spaces and closely considers the needs of the students. By providing a safe and trusted environment, where every student is heard, Valeo strives to take a holistic approach to care, focusing on both students' emotional well-being and educational growth.



Contact with parents

Valeo Primary School maintains close contact with parents through modern means of communication. Parents can easily connect with the school via WhatsApp and email. In addition, parents are regularly kept informed via an informative newsletter.

To report student progress, Valeo uses the Parnassys system. Although parents do not have direct access to this system, they can always request a printed version of their child's progress. This approach ensures transparent communication and ensures that parents remain involved in their children's learning.
